



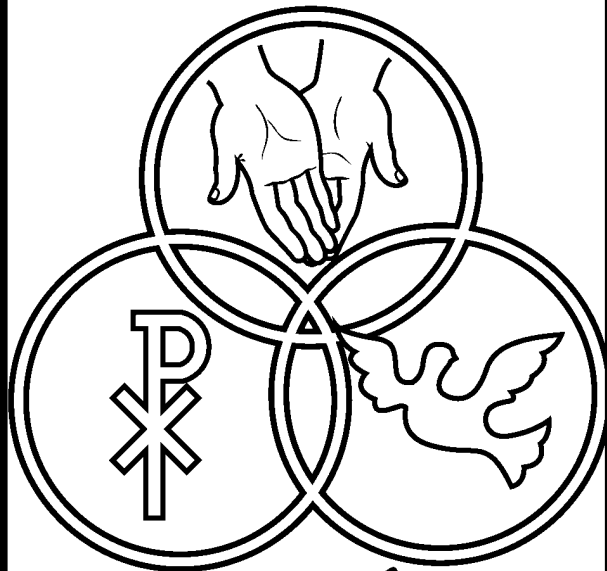

PRAISE TO THE CREATOR

The first reading, from Proverbs, is a beautiful doxology of the glory of Christ, who existed before all of creation. Christ is the Wisdom of God spoken of in the verse: “from of old I was poured forth, / at the first, before the earth” (Proverbs 8:23). Christ is described in terms of preexistence, of knowledge and wisdom of God, as the Child of God in whom the Creator delights, playing on the earth and delighting in the human race. Psalm 8 continues this hymn of praise to the Creator, enumerating all the wonders of creation, and marveling at the wonderful truth that God has put humanity at the forefront of it all, making us a little less than angels, “crowned with glory and honor” (Psalm 8:6).

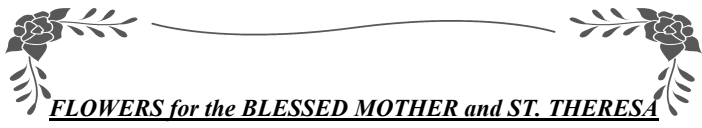

WHY FINGERPRINTING?

We at St. Theresa appreciate all of the volunteer's tie and patience as they go through the Safe Environment Program, which includes the fingerprinting submission as well as watching the Safe Environment video and taking the quiz. Several people in the various ministries have asked the reason for this program. The answer is St. Theresa Catholic Church complies with the Policies of the Diocese of Orlando. According to Policy and Procedures for Screening of Church Personnel for the Diocese of Orlando:

"The Diocese of Orlando is committed to doing everything in its power to ensure the safety of all those entrusted to its care, particularly children, the elderly, and the disabled. All employees, priests, religious brothers and sisters, volunteers and Church personnel in the Diocese of Orlando will be screened in accordance with this Policy."

The Diocese provides the following Glossary of Terms:

*"An **employee** is any lay person who is employed by or engaged in ministry in any Diocesan entity, whether part-time or full-time, who is given payment for services rendered. A **volunteer** is any unpaid person engaged or involved in a Diocesan activity, or who is involved in a Diocesan ministry and has contact with children, young adults, mentally-challenged children or adults, or the elderly or the disabled, whether in the parish, a hospital, nursing home, or residential setting, including pastoral visits and distribution of communion. For purposes of this policy only, **Church Personnel** includes all individuals who minister, work or volunteer in any school, parish or ministry of the Diocese."*

According to the Policies and Procedures for the Screening of Church Personnel:

"Any modification or deviation of the Policy and Procedures must be approved in writing. Church personnel who fail to follow the Policy and Procedures of the Diocese will be subject to discipline, up to and including termination of employment, removal from ministry or cessation of volunteer activity."

THE BODY OF CHRIST HAS AIDS:

IF ONE OF US IS INFECTED, ALL OF US ARE AFFECTED

It is not sufficient to be pro-life in some issues, we must be pro-life on all issues. HIV and AIDS raise ethical questions that find answers in our biblical roots (already discussed), the Papal teachings and our Bishops.

Pope John Paul II proclaimed the Christian understanding of the value of life. Created in God's image, redeemed by Jesus, called to everlasting life, every human being is sacred and social, every human being is a sign of God's love.

Human dignity is the foundation of all the social teachings. All persons have worth and dignity, rooted simply in who they are (and not in what they do or achieve). Situations that limit or undermine human dignity cry out for change. All forms of discrimination are wrong, whether in housing, jobs, insurance, health care or religion. Our response to persons living with HIV/AIDS must be such that we discover Christ in them and they, in turn, can encounter Christ in us.

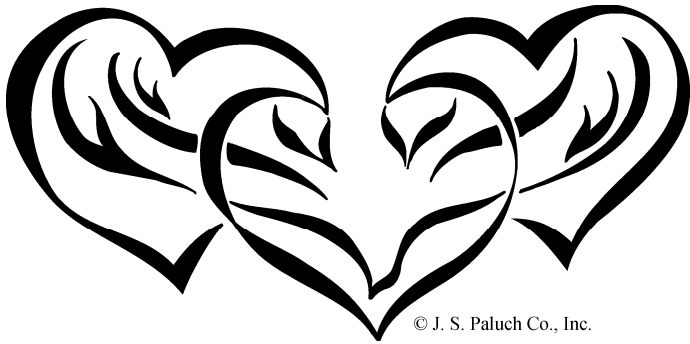
